

## #2: Doll Gowns

Bronson Children's Hospital performs up to 90 surgeries each month on pediatric patients, infant through teenagers. Facing surgery is scary. Bronson's child life specialists soothe fears and bring comfort to help children cope and make every surgery a positive experience for all. Before surgery, a child may tour the surgery area with a child life specialist. Children age 3-11 are offered a doll-sized Patient Gown that they may put on their own stuffed animal or doll and take it into surgery with them. There is a need for more doll gowns, and the instructions are printed below, as well as the link to the pdf pattern. You will also find the pattern on the next page of this newsletter.

### Doll Gown Instructions:

Print the doll gown pattern at 100% onto 8.5 x 11" paper.

Once the pattern is printed, compare the ruler in the printout to another ruler to make sure the pattern is the correct size.

Place pattern and cut:

For the Back - place the pattern on double layer of fabric and cut (2 pieces).

For the Front - place the pattern on the fold of the fabric and cut (1 piece).

Place right sides together.

Sew sides and shoulder seams. All seams should be 1/4".

Zigzag stitch around the neck of the gown. If you have time, zigzag around all raw edges.

Sew binding or bias tape around neck, leaving 5-7 inches extra on each end to allow for tying.

Hem bottom, back and armholes (tip: it is easier to hem the armholes before you sew it together).



